Cave Run Sailing Association, Cave Run Lake, Morehead, KY



The *Cave Run Sailing Association* invites you to join us for our *46th Grand Annual Regatta*.
Located in the heart of the Daniel Boone National Forest,
Autumn foliage makes Cave Run Lake a beautiful place to sail.

Location:

The **Boat Gunnel Camp Area** at the Twin Knobs Campground has been reserved by CRSA for the weekend and the Pavilion area will serve as the **Regatta Headquarters** for check-in, meals, and social activities. Site pavilion has power and water access, and is fully covered under-roof with banquet-style picnic tables. Convenient, well maintained modern facilities are located on-site.

- A limited number of tent (river rock base) and RV camping sites are available for starting Friday night.

- Nearby **Twin Knobs Campground** is available for a separate fee. Participants desiring the Twin Knobs Camping Area are responsible for making their own reservations

Rules:

The *46th Grand Annual Regatta* will be governed by the rules as defined by the current edition of the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing, except as any of these are altered by this NOR or the Sailing Instructions. RRS Appendix V applies.

Eligibility and Entry:

- Entry is open to all sailors and boats in good standing with US Sailing and having a *standard* Portsmouth rating. US Sailing membership is *not* required.
- *On-line registration* is encouraged and will be available beginning June 2, 2025 at <https://www.caverunsailing.org/regattas/grand-annual-regatta/>.
- *On-site registration* will begin Saturday, October 4, 2025, at 9:00AM.
- Entry fees
 - Entry includes breakfast (2), lunch (2), Saturday dinner and one (1) shirt.
 - Each boat skipper, age 20+ registered online
 - \$70 until Sept. 20.
 - Day-of-race registration will be \$80.

- Junior registration, for skippers aged 19 and under will be \$50.
- Additional crew or guest (each) \$25 and includes breakfast (2), lunch (2), Saturday dinner.
- Additional shirts are available for \$20.

Fleets and Scoring:

- A minimum of five boats constitutes a fleet with separate starts. Classes may be consolidated or expanded for competition based on registrations and Portsmouth handicaps. This will be finalized and disseminated at the Skipper’s meeting.
 - Catalina 22 Fleet 149
 - Single-handed will be grouped as a single fleet unless there is enough of a class to score separately.
- Scoring will be RRS Appendix A, as amended by the Sailing Instructions.
- The number of races is dependent on weather conditions, starting as many races as possible. No races will be started after 1300 on Sunday, October 5.
- A minimum of one race constitutes a regatta
- *All races shall be scored.* (This changes RRS A2.1.)
- Protests must be filed within 1 hour (60 minutes) of docking of the committee boat.
- Trophies will be awarded to the top three finishers in each class.
- As wind on the lake is highly changeable (which makes a great technical challenge!), please note that *squareness may be traded to complete more races* based on discretion of the race official.

Sailing Instructions:

Sailing Instructions will be posted on the CRSA web page and will be available at the registration site *to all registered boats*. Changes to the sailing instructions will be posted at the *Regatta Headquarters* registration site.

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Launching Facilities:

Boat Launching facilities are available at the *Scott Creek Boat Ramp* (fee), the *Stoney Cove Boat Ramp* or through the *Twin Knobs Campground* Facility.

- **Passes for the Twin Knobs Campground** launch area are included, and as of this writing the Forest Service does not list a fee for the Stoney Cove Boat Ramp, which is near the western end of the Cave Run Lake Dam.
- **Passes for the Scott Creek Boat Ramp** (\$5/day or \$7/3-day) can be purchased at the Ranger Station, the store across from the ramp, and the Scott Creek Marina office. The pass is required to use the ramp or park in the ramp area and is enforced.
- **Scott Creek Marina is a full-service marina** including fuel, convenience store, restroom facilities, and table service restaurant adjacent to boat ramp
